# Sun River Snapshot June, 2021



The mission of Sun River's CSAT HIV & HepB/C MAT program is to ensure accessible, effective, compassionate care for all persons in Suffolk county at risk for substance misuse, mental health and chronic disease. This program has a special focus on linking persons with HIV and/or OUD to medication assisted treatment & team based care coordination to address social determinants and MH risks.

## **Program Reach**



23,822 patients tested for HIV & 14,408 tested for Hep B/C\*



**521** patients engaged in case management program



**521** patients received opioid pharmacotherapy



**4882** patients, staff, public trained to use Narcan\*

70% of patients discharging from Sun River also made plans for other treatment and/or recovery services

47% have depression63% have anxiety




**48%** of patients are receiving mental health medications






Program outcomes based on follow-up interviews with 79% of patients (358 total)
