The mission of Sun River's CSAT HIV & HepB/C MAT program is to ensure accessible, effective, compassionate care for all persons in Suffolk county at risk for substance misuse, mental health and chronic disease. This program has a special focus on linking persons with HIV and/or OUD to medication assisted treatment & team based care coordination to address social determinants and MH risks.

23,822 patients tested for HIV &
14,408 tested for Hep B/C*



521 patients engaged in case management program



521 patients received opioid pharmacotherapy



4882 patients, staff, public trained to use Narcan*



70% of patients discharging from Sun River also made plans for other treatment and/or recovery services

47% have depression
63% have anxiety

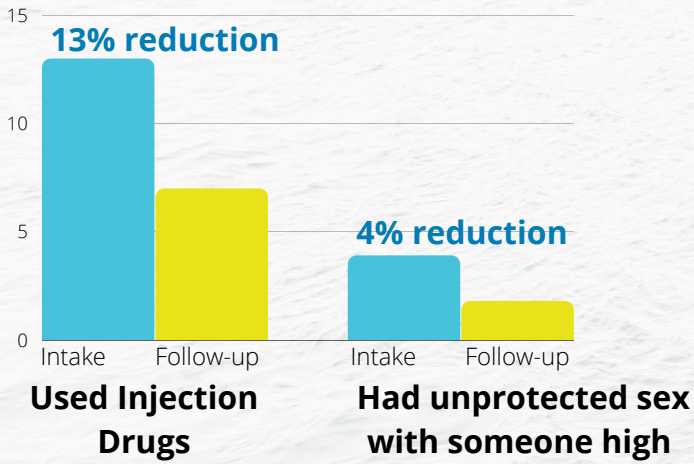


48% of patients are receiving mental health medications

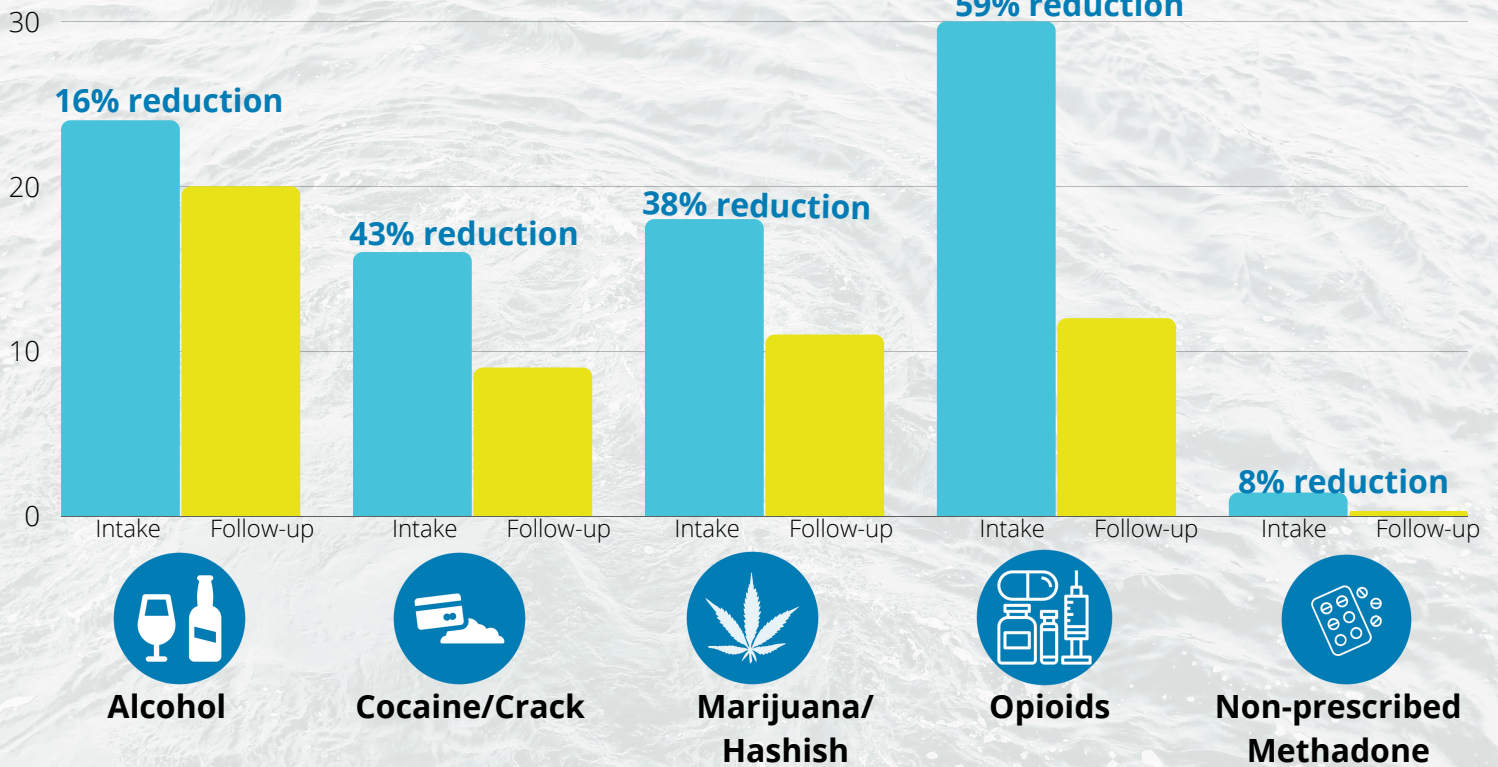
Risky Behaviors
